

Juvenile Corrections Advisory Board (JCAB) Responsibilities

JJOC Reinvestment Subcommittee

January 11, 2019

- Annually, consider availability of treatment programs, programs creating alternatives to incarceration, mental health treatment, and the development of risk assessment tools (if not already in existence) for use in determining pretrial release and probation supervision levels (K.S.A. 75-7044a)
- Report to KDOC and JJOC detailing costs of programs needed in the judicial district to reduce out-of-home placement of juvenile offenders and improve the rate of recidivism of juvenile offenders (K.S.A. 75-7044a)
- Adhere to the goals of the juvenile justice code (K.S.A. 75-7046)
- Coordinate with the Kansas JJOC (K.S.A. 75-7046)
- Actively participate in the formulation of the comprehensive plan for the development, implementation, and operation of juvenile correctional services (K.S.A. 75-7046)
- Make a formal recommendation to the BOCC at least annually concerning the comprehensive plan and its implementation and operation during the ensuing year (K.S.A. 75-7046)
 - This formal recommendation shall include provisions to address racial, geographic and other biases that may exist in the juvenile justice system.

- Review data specific to local community and make decisions based on such data to improve services to kids and families
 - Monitor fiscal plan (with comp plan)
 - Establish local policy in line with juvenile justice code
 - Represent the community in regard to policy development and implementation
 - Communicate with, educate, and engage local citizens on community's efforts
 - Secure additional funding, when needed
 - Creation of outcome measures for judicial district
 - Evaluation of strategies
 - Coordinate local initiatives in line with larger state initiatives
