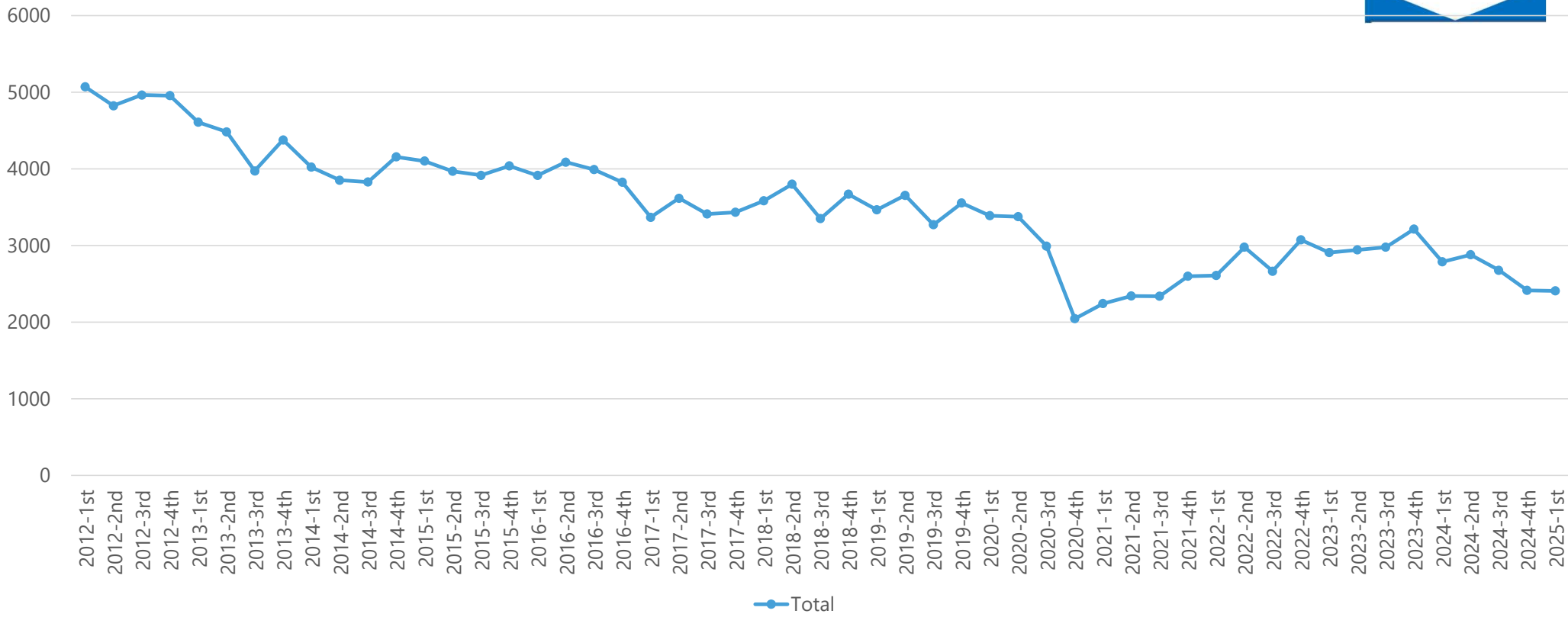

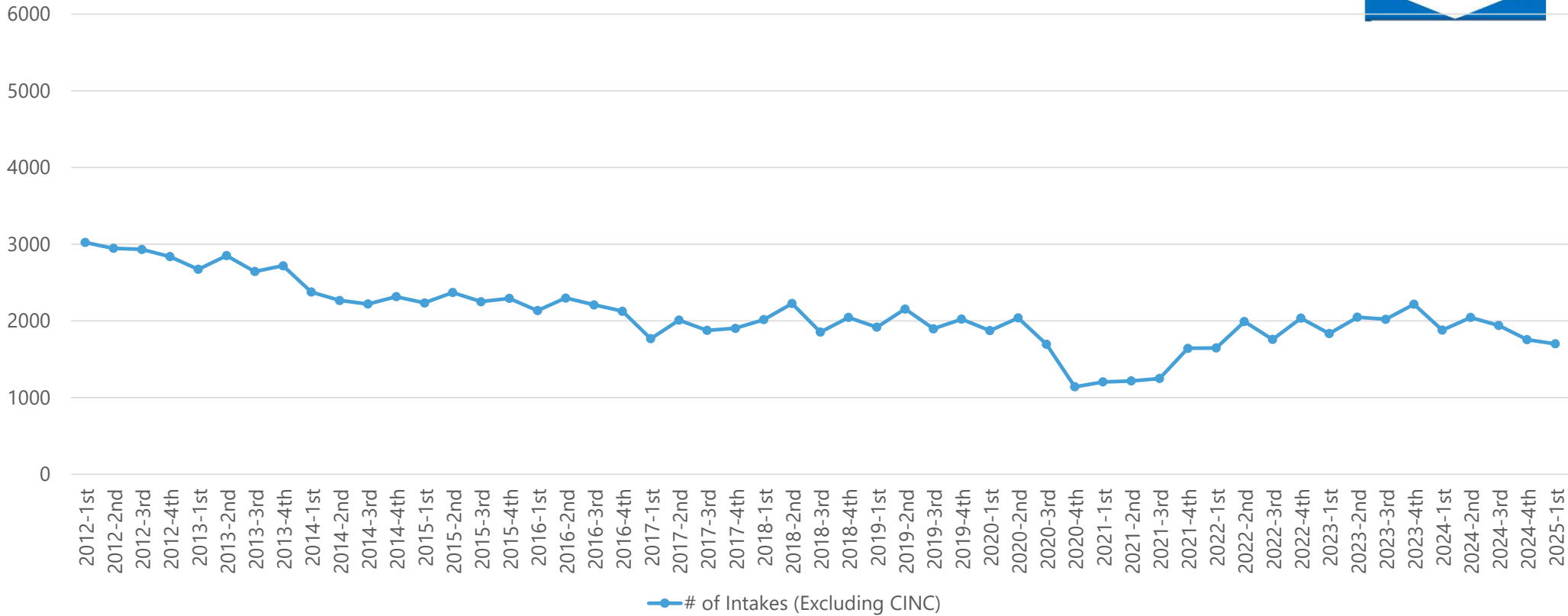

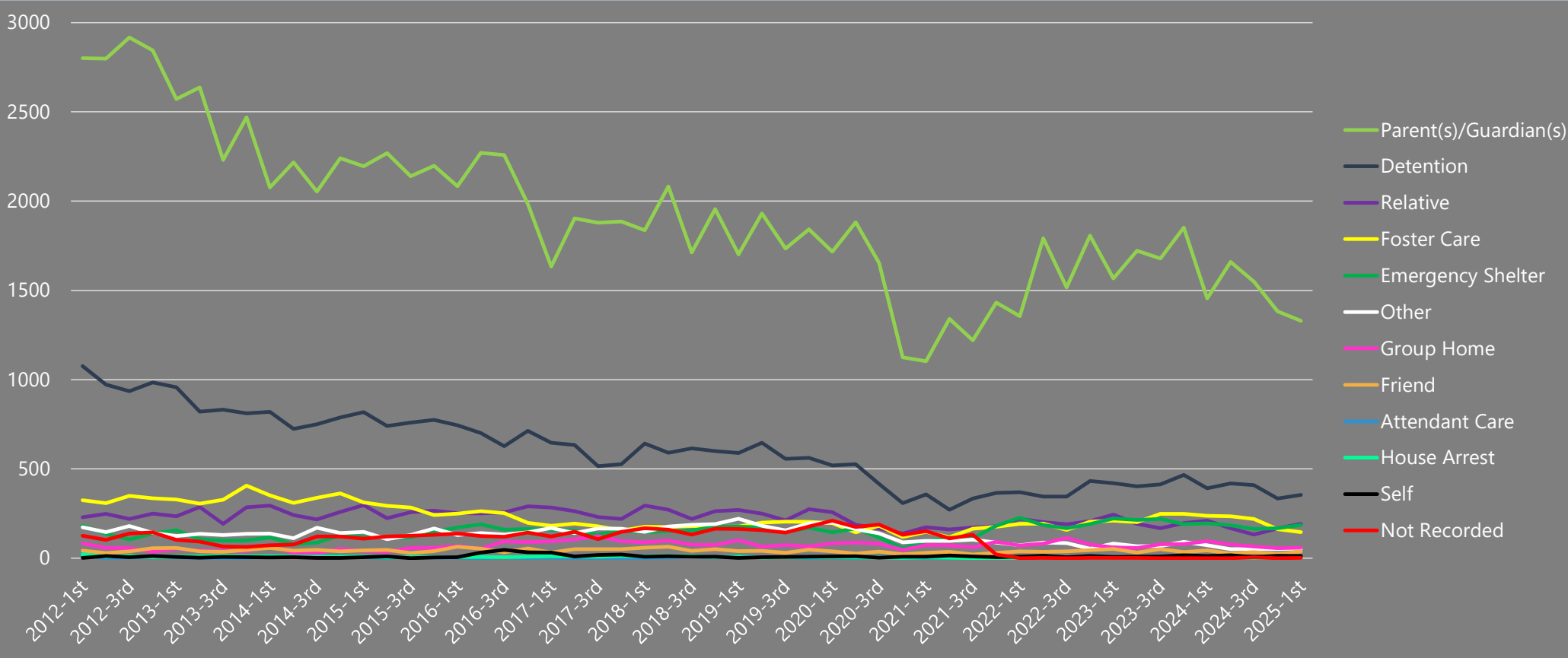
Juvenile Intakes (excludes CINC)



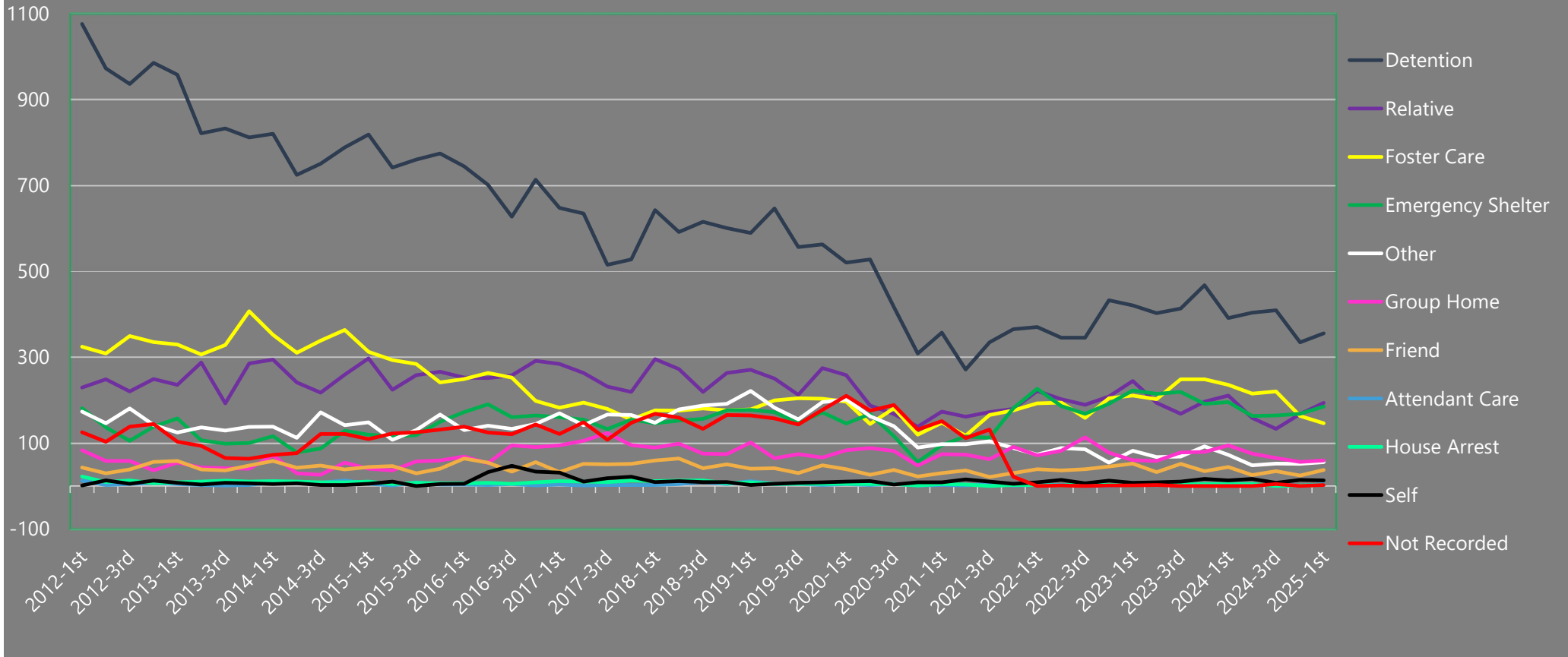

Intakes by Placement Outcome



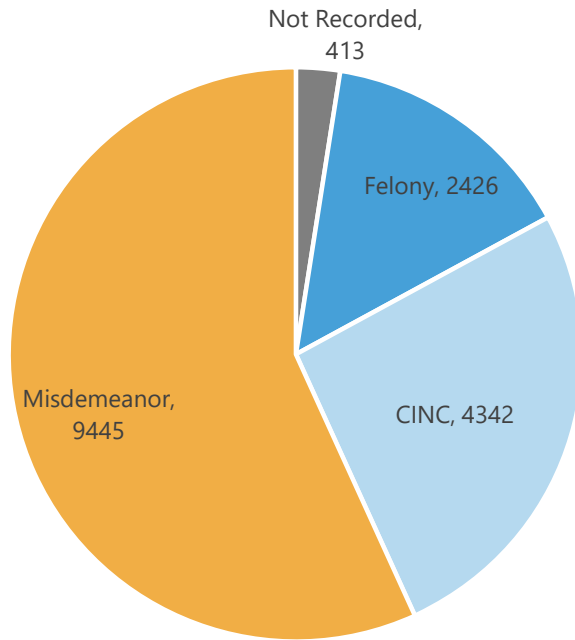
Intakes by Placement Outcome (excluding Parents/Guard)



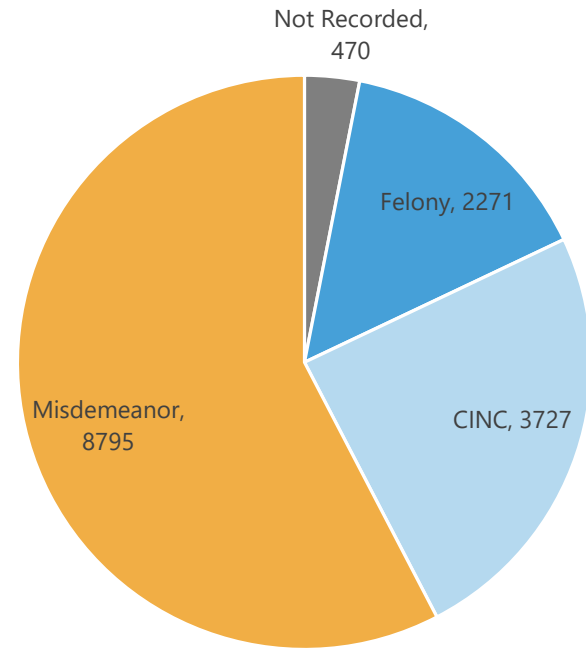
Reason for Intake - FY 2022 & 2023

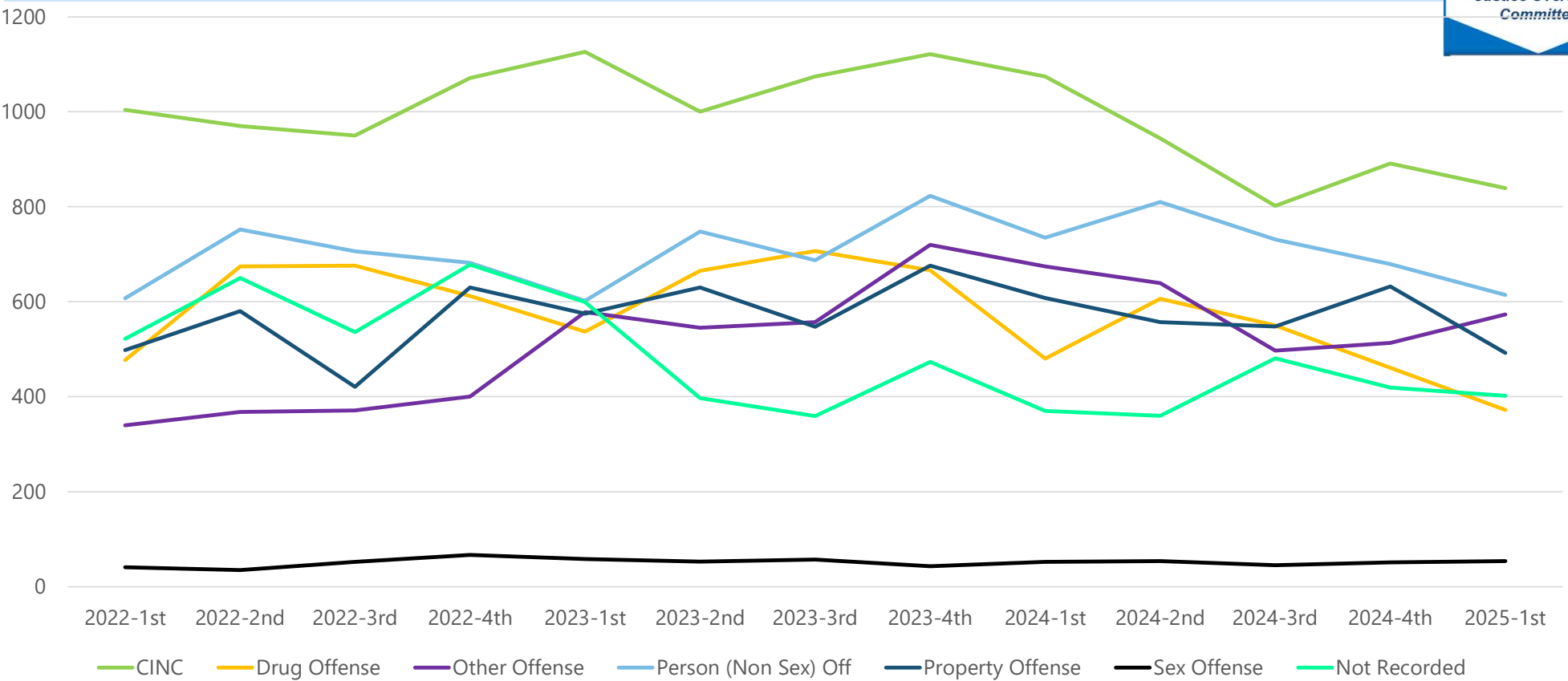

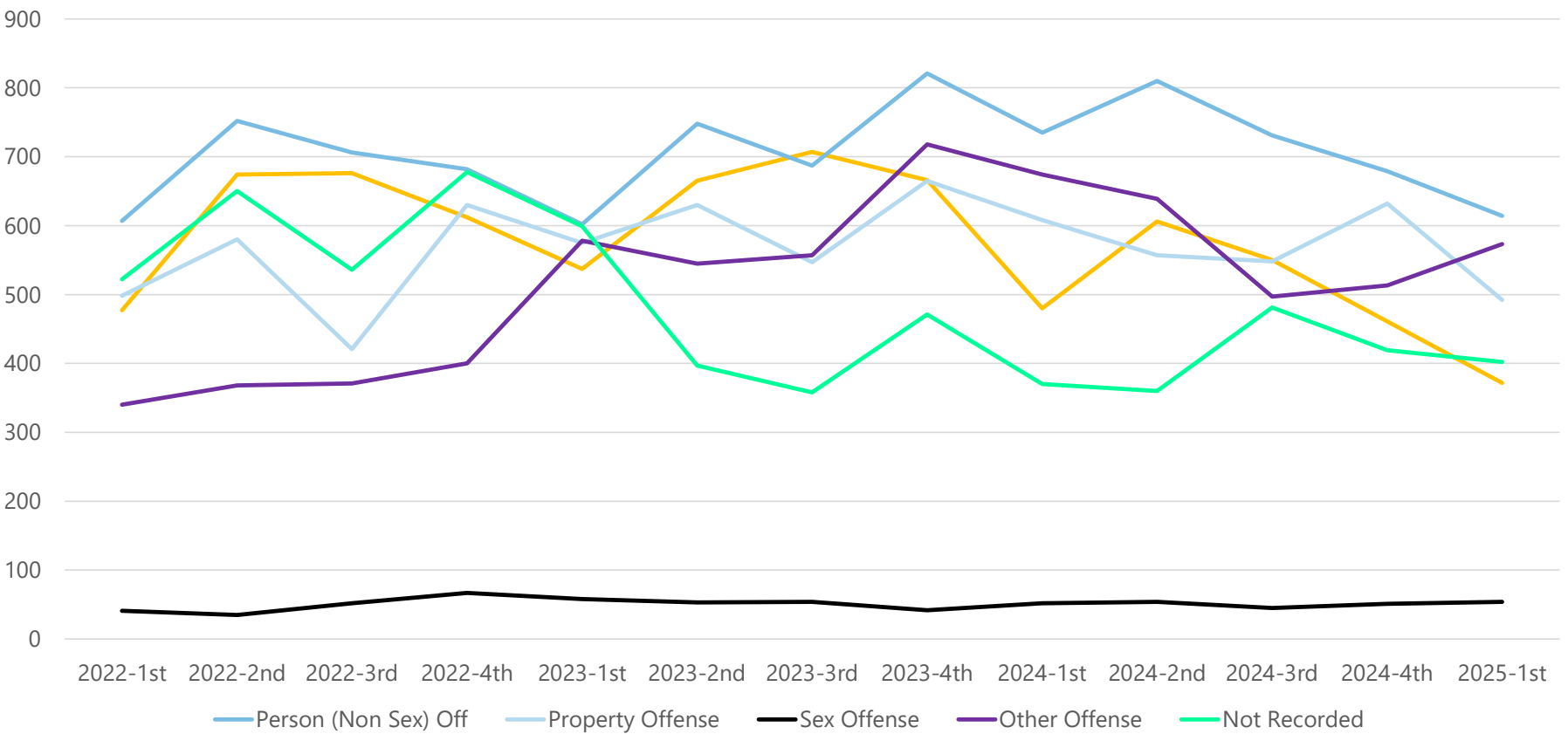

Intake by Cause/Offense Type

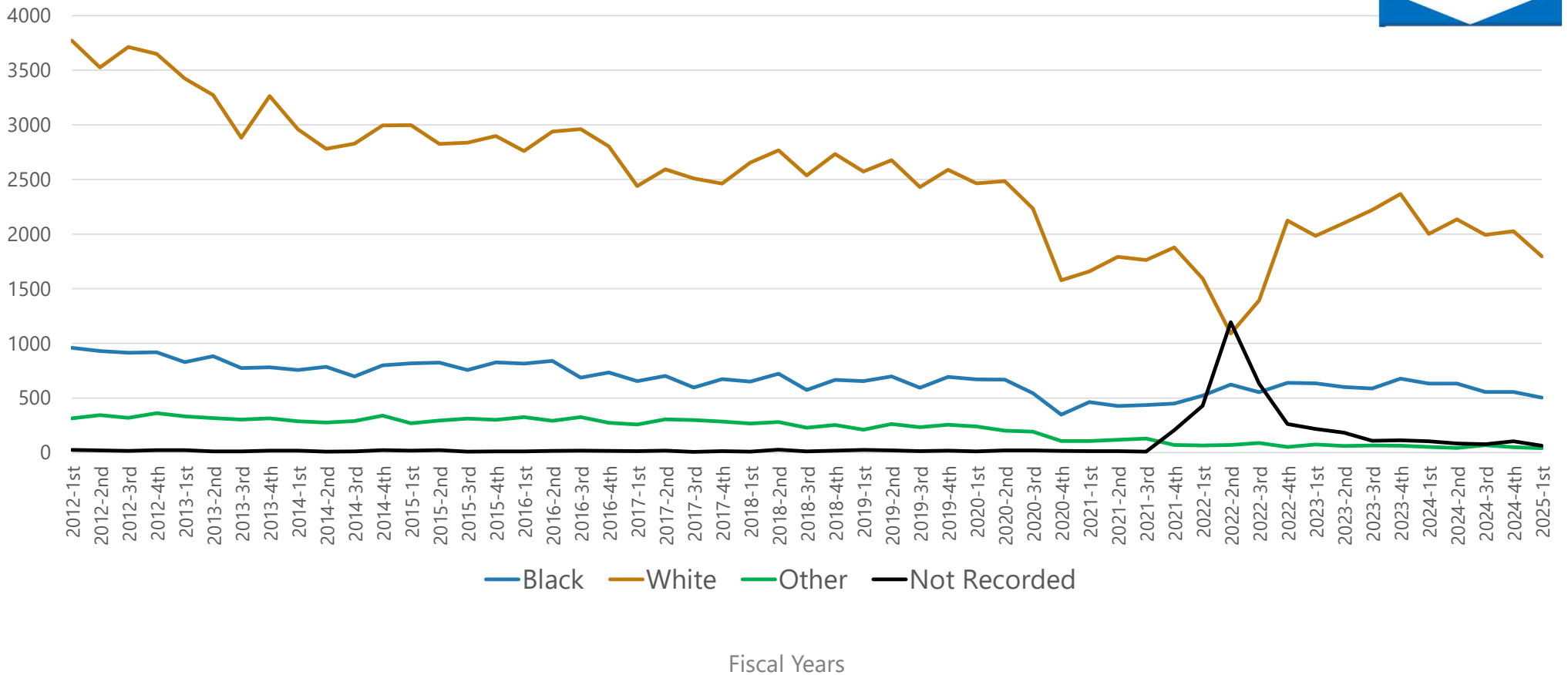

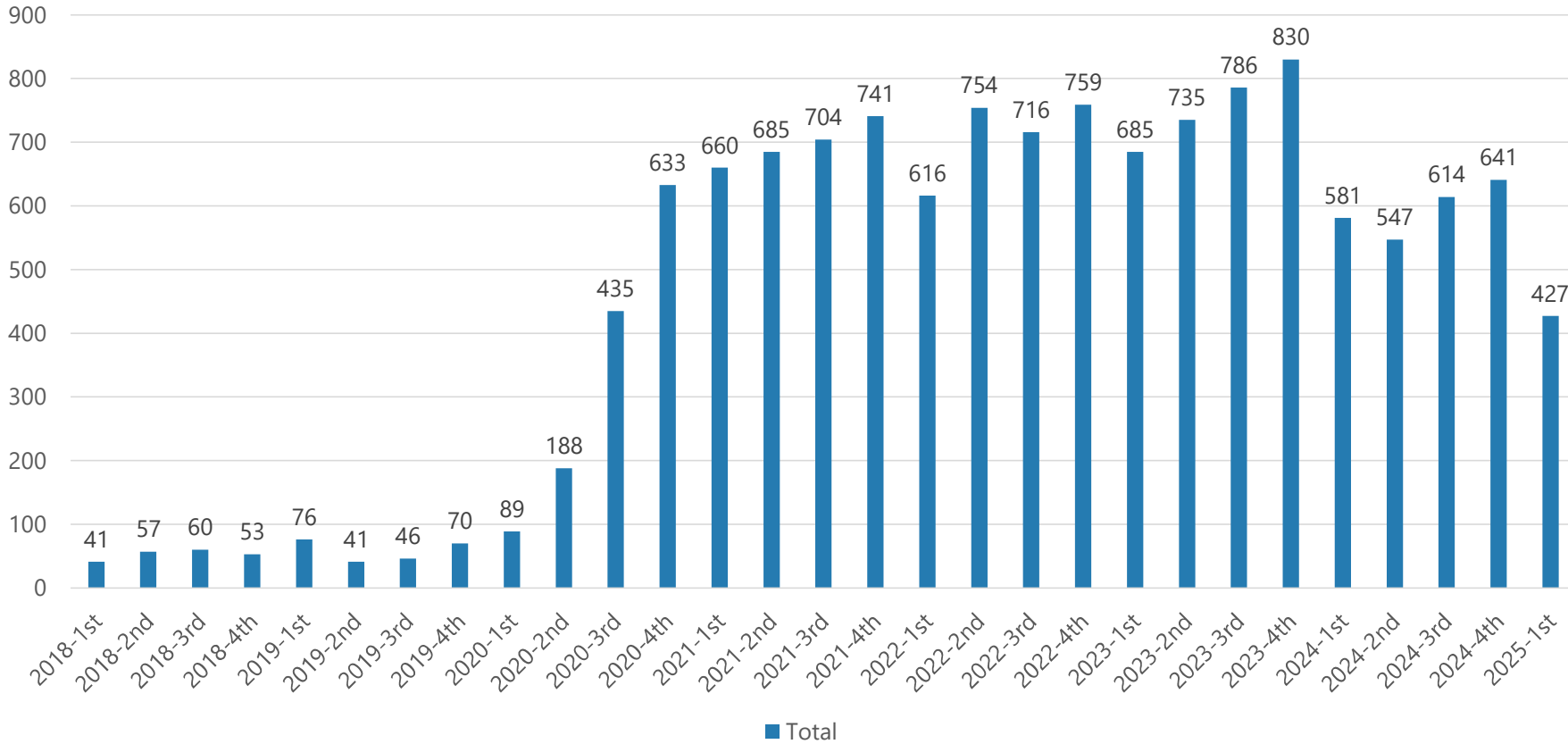

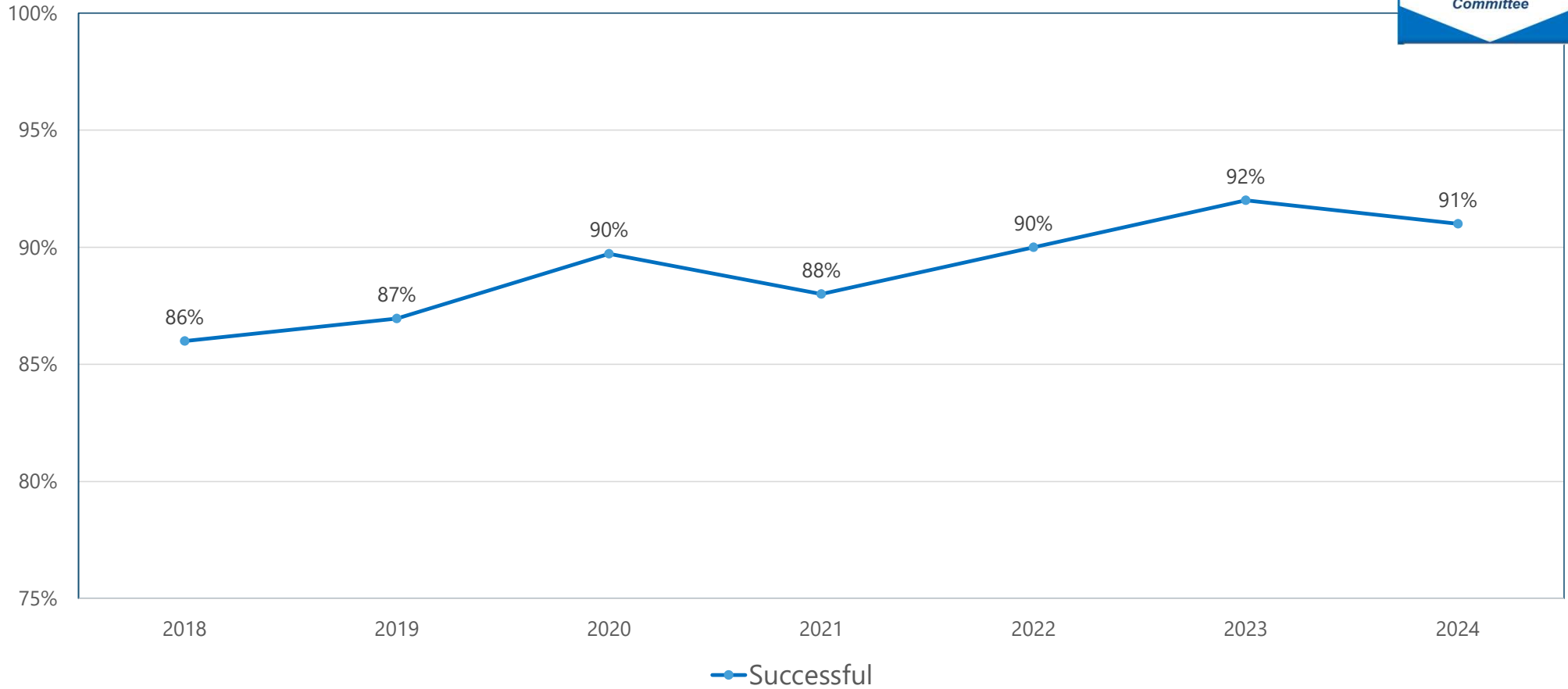

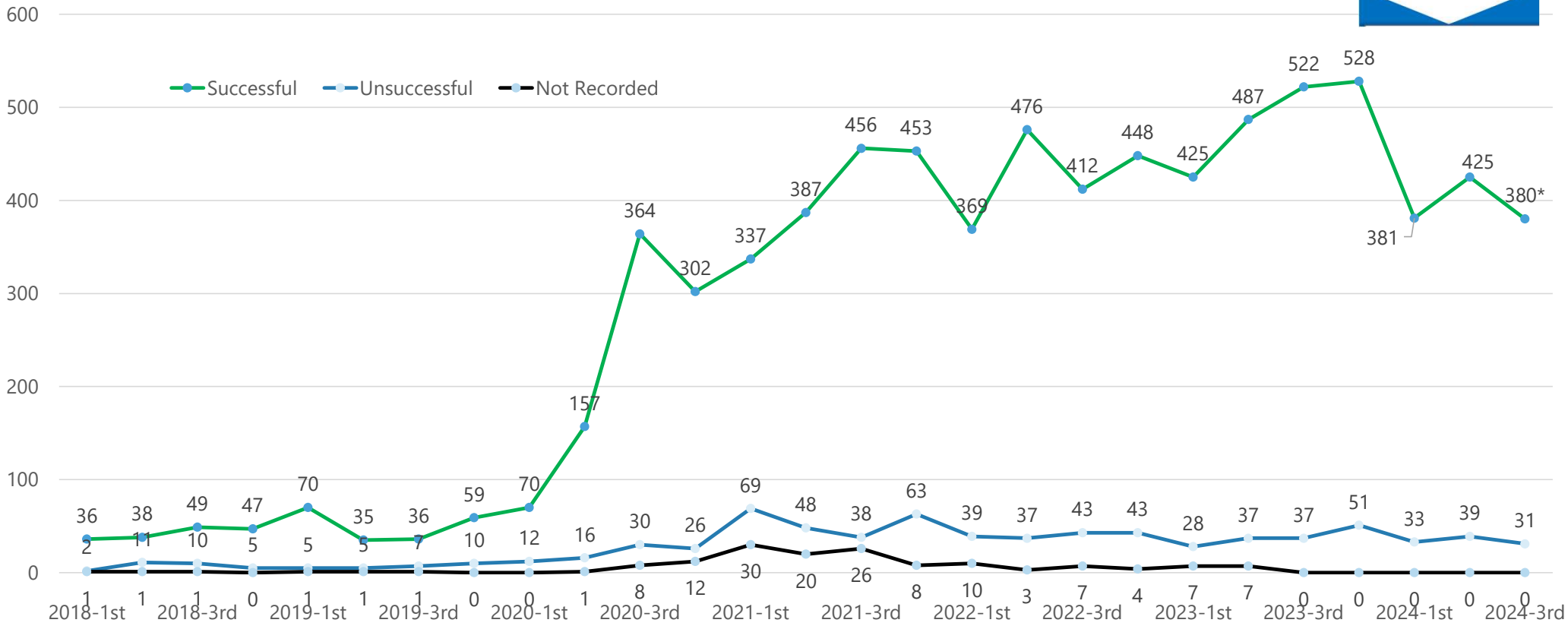

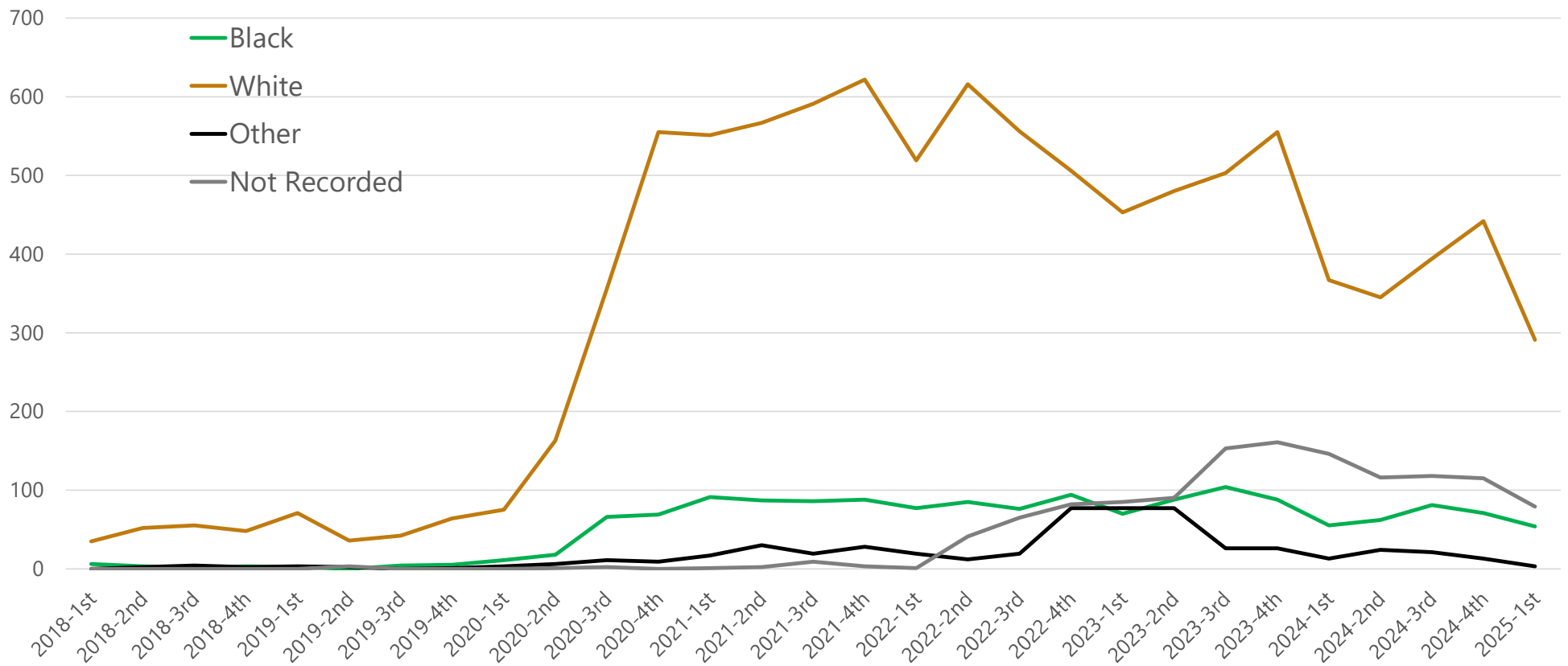

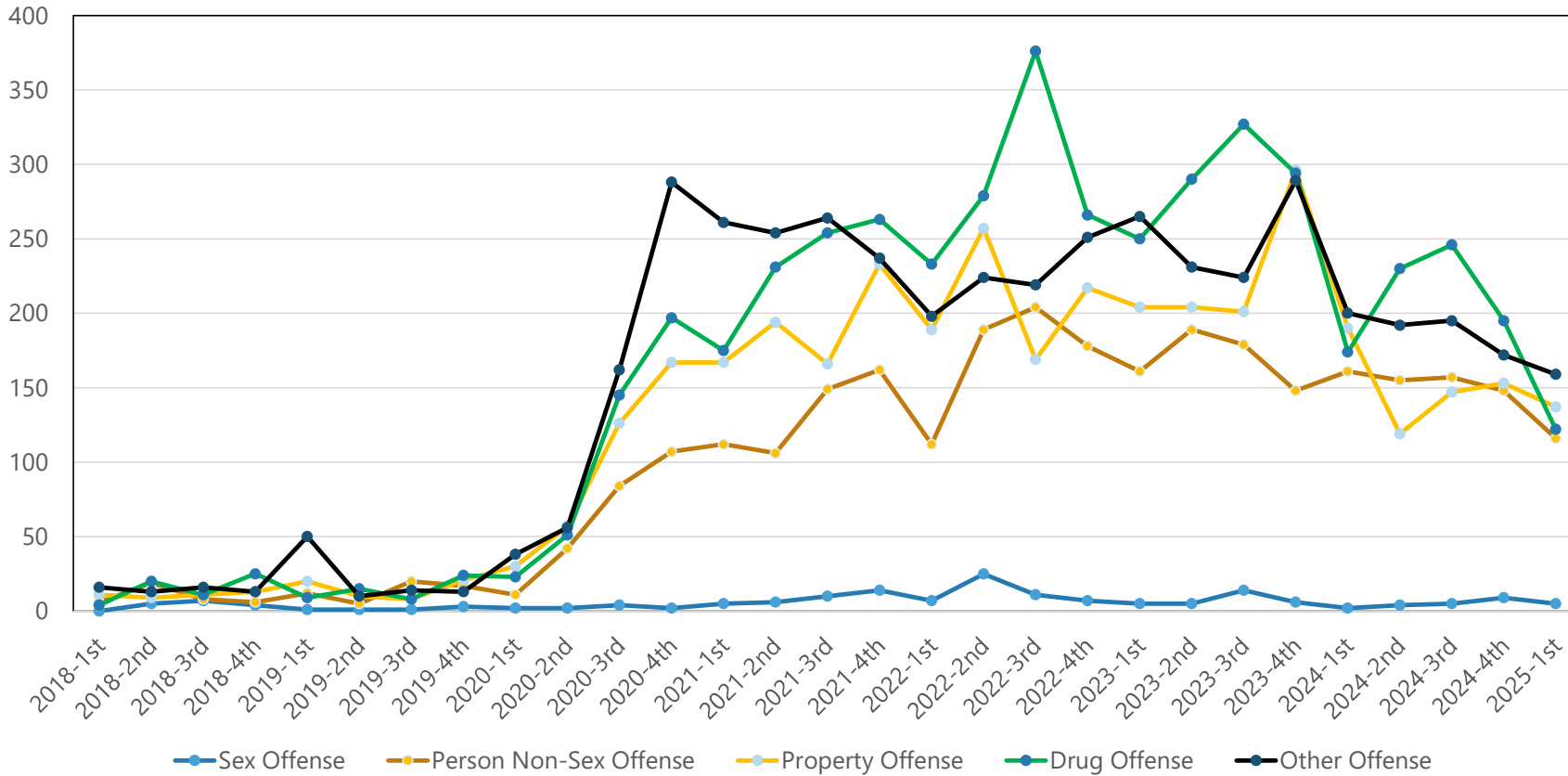

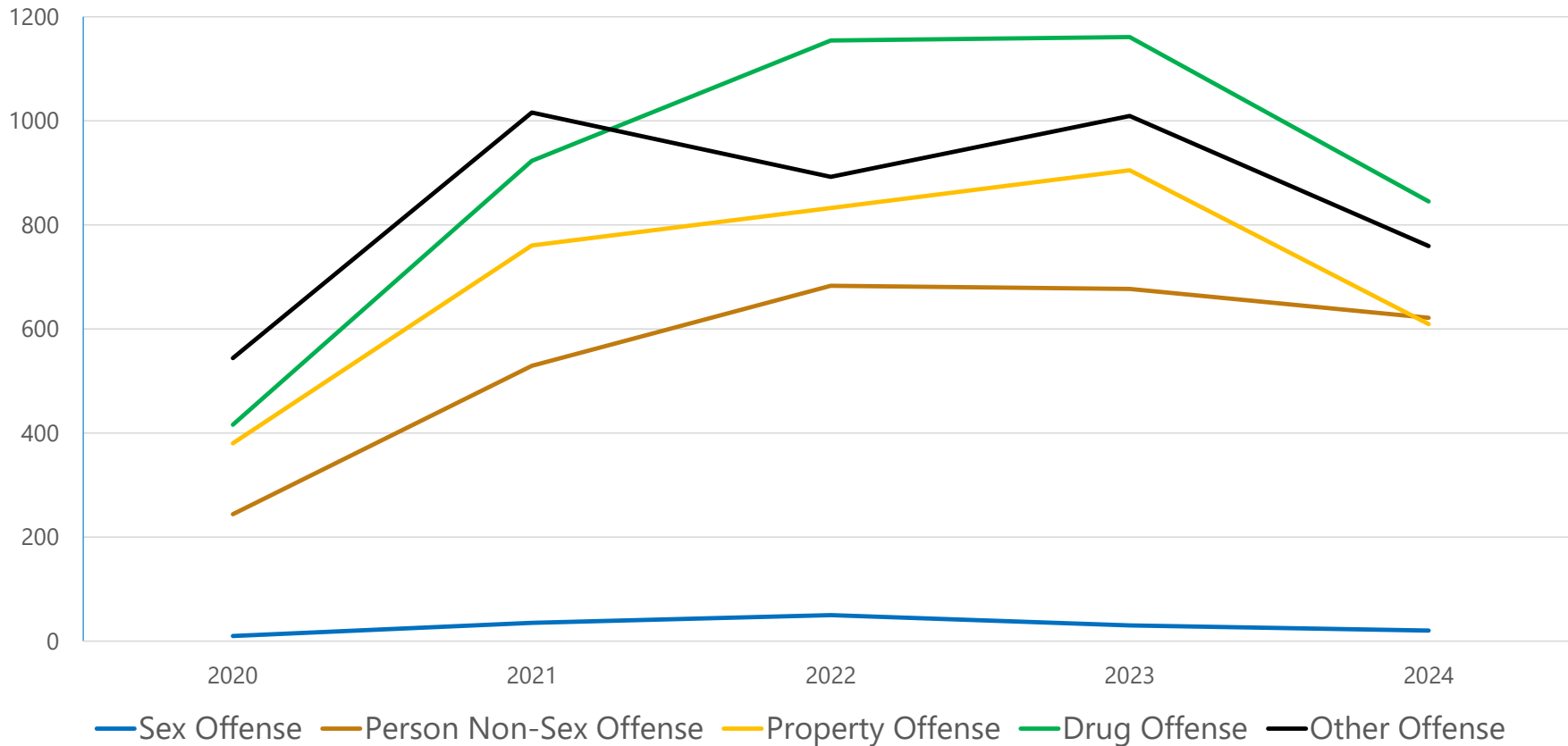

Change in IIP In FY 2024, 1st Quarter we saw...

30% decline (249 youth) in IIP and a 25% increase (55) in ISP

28% decrease in youth completing Successful

36% decrease in youth completing Unsuccessful

Race decline:

Black 38%

White 34%

Other 50% (13 youth)

Gender Decline

Male 33%

Femail 25%

Offense Type:

Sex Offense Decline 66% (4 youth)

Person: Increase 8% (20 youth)

Drug Decline 40%

Other Decline 30%

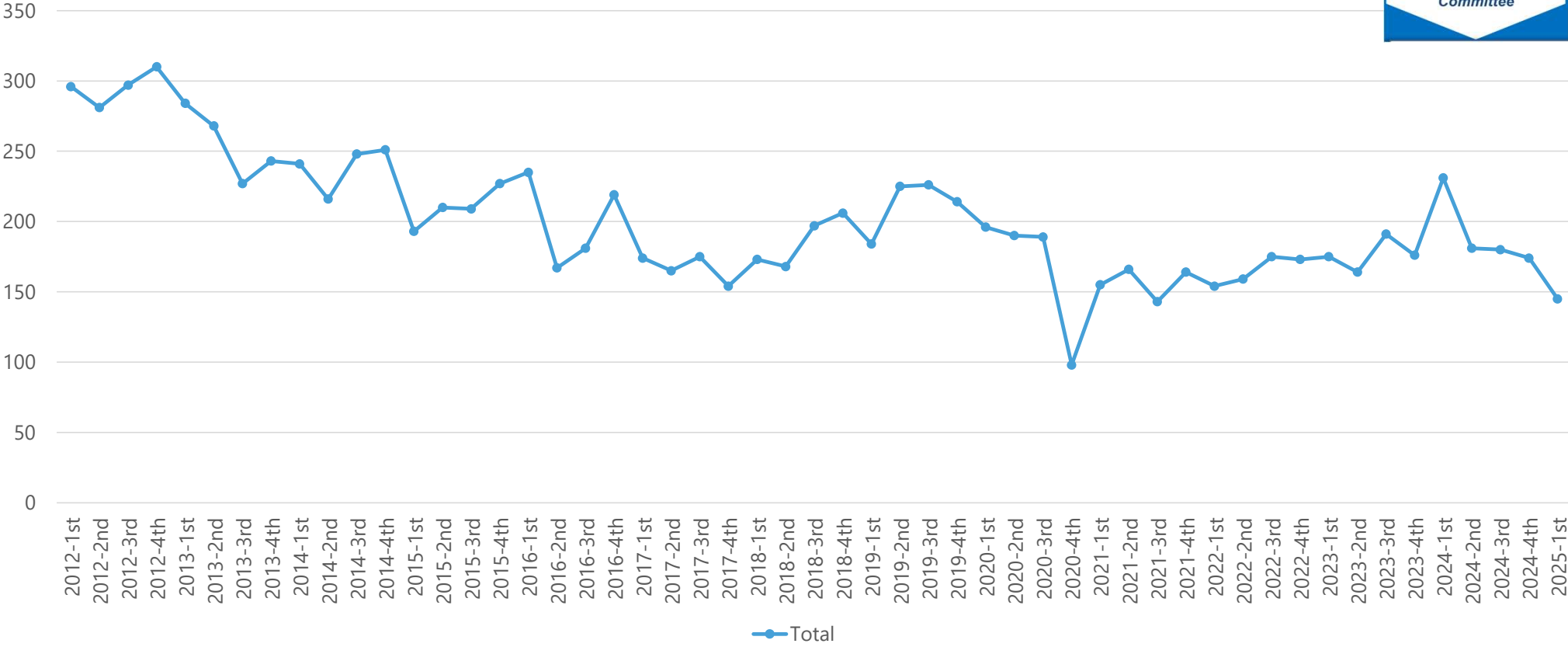

Total Ordered to JISP

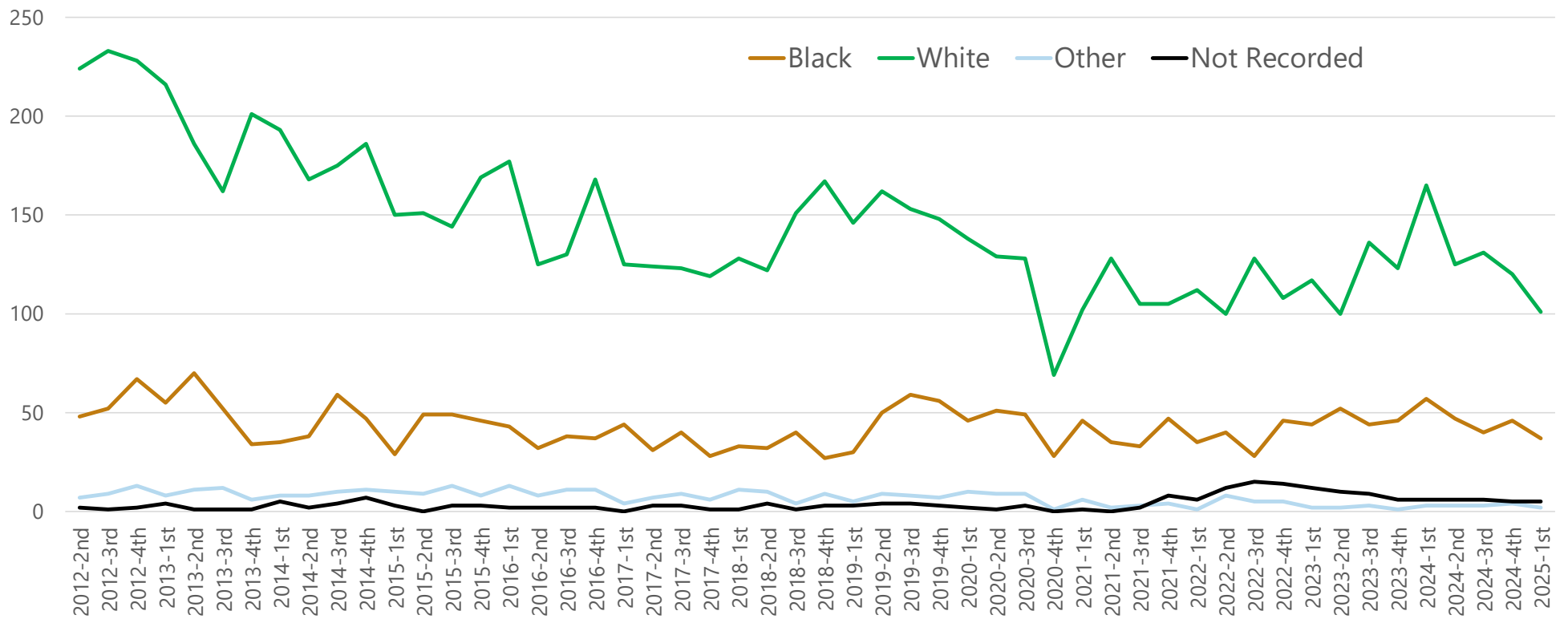


Ordered to JISP by Race

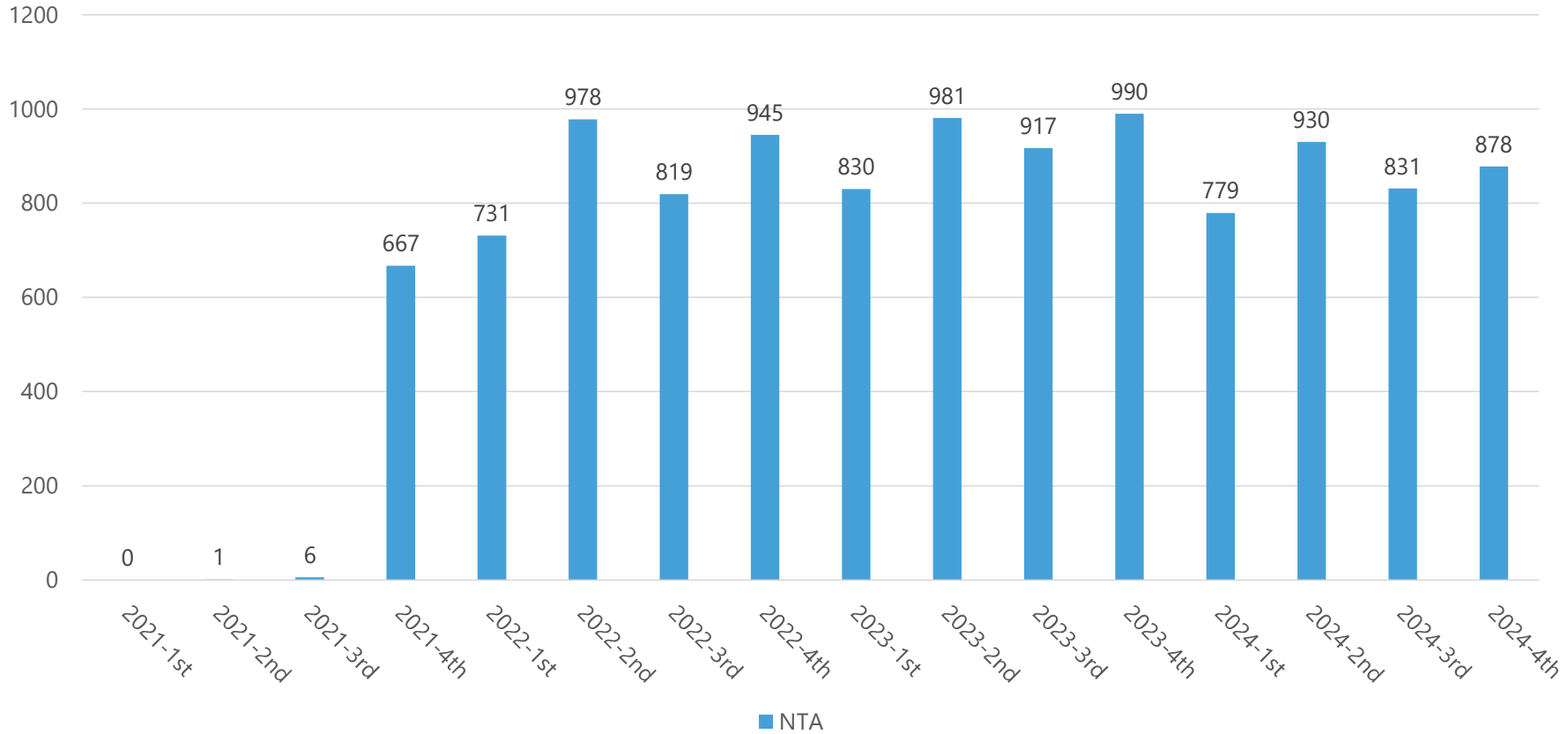

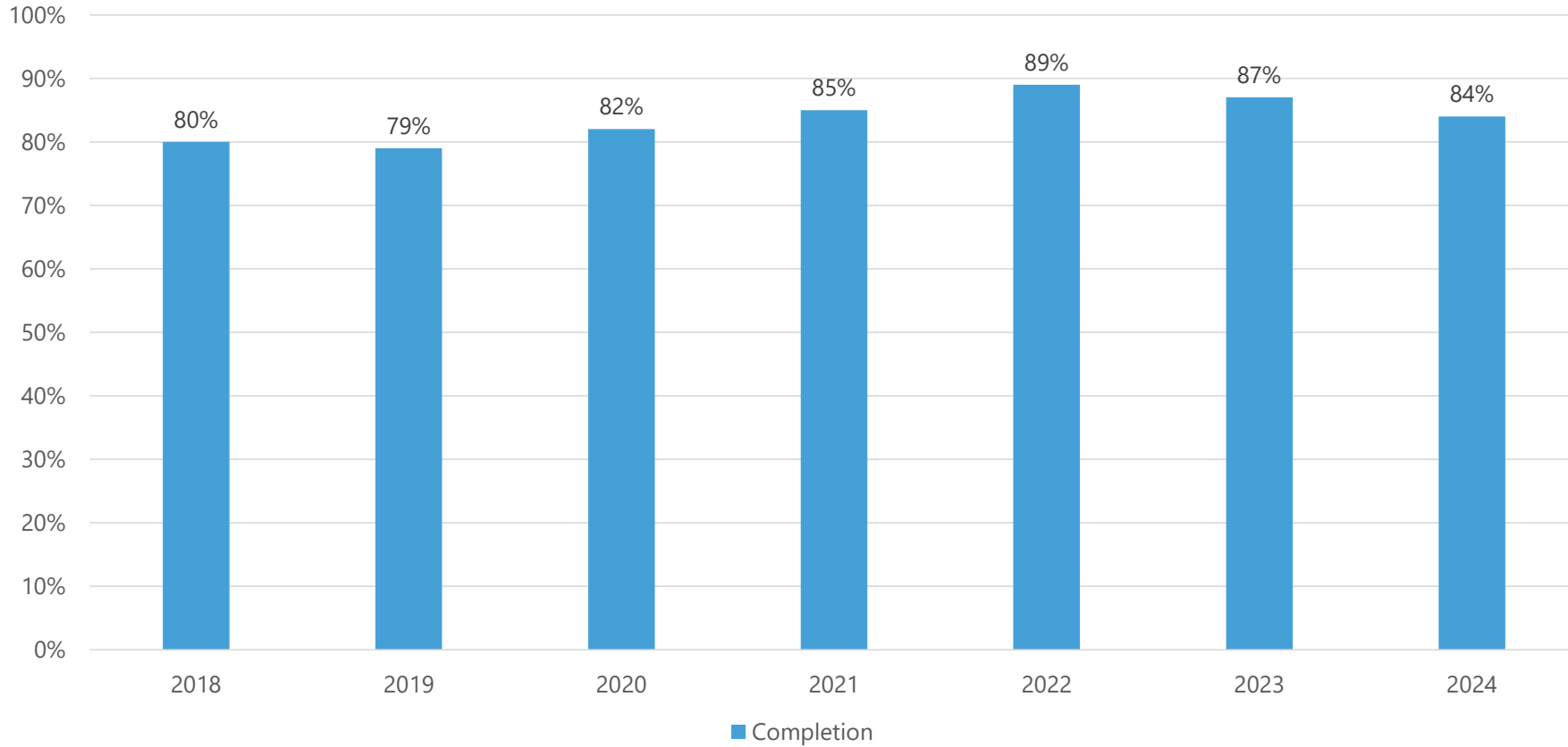
