Eligibility:

- **JCAB Grants:** Eligible Applicants: Juvenile Corrections Advisory Boards.
- **Reinvestment Grants:** Eligible Applicants: Community Supervision Offices to include Juvenile Intake and Assessment, Court Services, Immediate Intervention Programs, and Community Corrections.
- Grant award period of two (2) years.
- The grant is designed to fund the development and implementation of evidence-based programs and practices that aim to improve outcomes for youth, families, and communities in Kansas by supporting community-based programs.
