STANDARD: Written policy, procedure and practice shall require that for cases in which a juvenile is placed in a licensed Foster Home, upon the Court's request for a six (6) month foster parent report, the Community Supervision Agency shall provide:

- The foster parents with a copy of the JS-0090 form
- At least two (2) weeks' notice to the foster parents prior to a six (6) month foster parent report being due for submission to the Court

The six (6) month time period begins upon the juvenile being placed in the foster home.

DISCUSSION: None.

NOTE: The standards and procedures set forth herein are intended to establish operational guidelines for community supervision agencies operating through the board of county commissioners and their employees/contractors and the juvenile offenders under supervision. They are not intended to establish state created liberty interests for community supervision agencies, or the board of county commissioners, or their employees/contractors, or juvenile offenders, or an independent duty owed by the Kansas Department of Corrections- Division of Juvenile Services to community supervision agencies operating through the board of county commissioners or their employees/contractors, supervised juvenile offenders or third parties. This standard and procedure is not intended to establish or create new constitutional rights or to enlarge or expand upon existing constitutional rights or duties.
