Corrections Officers proximity to the offender during encounter	Disposable Isolation Gown, Gloves and Mask Determination	
	Asymptomatic or Symptomatic offender with or without mask for entire encounter.	Identified symptomatic offender who is unmasked offender or mask needs to be removed for any period of time during the offender encounter.
Offenders in General Population		
Corrections Officers during a pat down or full frisk, ensure patient is facing away from officer. This also include full strip search. (Potential exposure to an offender is a few seconds during pat down)	cloth mask at all times  No Gown needed	cloth mask at all times  No Gown needed
RETURN FROM OUTSIDE OF FACILITY ONLY: (Contact with community)		
Corrections Officers during a pat down or full frisk, ensure patient is facing away from officer. This also includes full strip search. (Potential exposure to an offender is a few seconds during pat down)	cloth mask at all times  No Gown needed	cloth mask at all times  No Gown needed

Corrections Officers Packing out Offenders	
Corrections Officers packing out items/belongings from a symptomatic or asymptomatic offender	Corrections Officer to wear cloth mask and gloves. * Gown only needed if immediate pack out within a few minutes after exit of the offender. 

***Symptomatic patient is exhibiting symptoms and COVID positive. Asymptomatic patient is COVID positive and is not exhibiting any symptoms.**

Remove PPE prior to leaving area. Do not walk around unit/area with gloves used during search or pack out without removing and washing hands.

Wash your hands after removing gloves with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
