In accordance with IMPP 01-101D, any attached IMPPs summarized below have had their revision/introduction advanced through appropriate procedures set forth within the context of that IMPP. Additionally, policy memoranda are sometimes issued on a very limited basis, and, if included in this distribution, are similarly summarized below. The following are summaries of the revisions to policy and/or procedures resulting from these processes, and have been reviewed in an attempt to ensure consistency with statutes, regulations, and the current needs and philosophy of the Department.

Per IMPP 01-101D, new and revised policies shall be distributed, prior to their implementation, to designated staff, contract personnel, volunteers, and when appropriate to offenders and designated agencies. The yellow highlighted IMPPs listed in this document are considered “**STAFF READ ONLY**” and shall not be included in the distributions to agencies or organizations not authorized such access.

- 10-114D** **PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: Availability of Emergency Medical, Dental and Behavioral Health Services.** Revisions to this policy include several new definitions added and changes in terminology. KDOC IMPP 10-114 is revoked effective 10/06/15.
- 10-116D** **PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: Dental Services for Offenders.** This policy has undergone significant revisions including removal of procedures from the “Policy Statement” and placed in the “Procedures” section, several new definitions added, and the inclusion of procedures for juvenile services. KDOC IMPP 10-116 is revoked effective 10/06/15.
- 10-117D** **PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: Health Care Screenings, Assessments, and Evaluations.** This policy has undergone significant revisions including removal of procedures from the “Policy Statement” and placed in the “Procedures” section, several definitions were added and deleted, inclusion of procedures for juvenile services, and revisions to attachment. KDOC IMPP 10-117 is revoked effective 10/06/15.
- 10-120A** **PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: Utilization of Offenders in the Health Services Area.** Minor revisions include the addition and deletion of definitions and changes in terminology. KDOC IMPP 10-120 is revoked effective 10/06/15.
- 10-135A** **PROGRAMS AND SERVICES: Medication Administration Keep-on-Person Medication Program.** This policy has undergone significant revisions including the removal of procedures from the “Policy Statement” and placed in the “Procedures” section, new definitions added, deletion of definitions, and changes in terminology. KDOC IMPP 10-135 is revoked effective 10/06/15.
