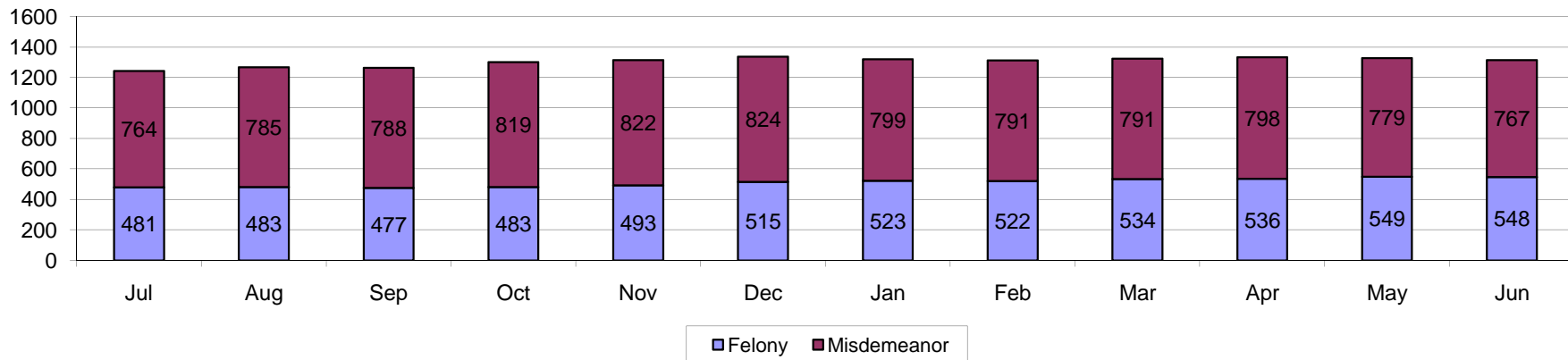

Juvenile Intensive Supervision Probation (JISP) is a structured community-based supervision program that provides an additional sentencing option to Kansas' courts. Youth on JISP have either previously failed traditional court service probation or have committed a serious offense, but do not require an out-of-home placement or commitment to a juvenile correctional facility. This data represents youth on JISP on the last day of the month during FY 2007. The number of youth on JISP with a felony offense has experienced an increase since September 2006, while the number of youth with a misdemeanor offense increased slightly over the first six months of the fiscal year, and then decreased in January 2007. On average, there are more youth on JISP with a misdemeanor offense than felony offense. The month with the highest number of youth on JISP is December, which is 2.5% higher than the average of all months in FY07.
